Yaquina Lighthouse Century
Saturday August 21, 2010



Three Scenic Routes

Century (100 miles) [\$30.00/rider]

Depart from Metric Century course at Siletz, going east up the Siletz River to Moonshine Park, then return to Siletz and then follow the Siletz River north to the Pacific shore. Ride north along the Siletz Bay and Drift Creek to Taft and then south along the scenic Oregon Coast Bicycle Route including the Otter Crest Loop bike lane with vistas at Fogerty Creek, Boiler Bay, Beverly Beach, and Agate Beach, before returning to Yaquina Head Lighthouse.

Metric Century Plus (70 miles) [\$30.00/rider]

Extend short course to include moderate climbing through Toledo and north to Siletz along the Siletz River to Kernville Junction and then south along the Oregon Coast Bike Route to Newport and the Yaquina Head Lighthouse.

Short Course (25 Miles) [\$15.00/rider]

See Yaquina Head and Yaquina Bay Lighthouses and the historic Old Town District of Newport. Enjoy 10 miles along beautiful Yaquina Bay. Watch for blue herons, egrets and bald eagles. Return to Yaquina Head Lighthouse.

Circle the route you choose: Short (25 mi.) Metric Plus (72 mi.) Century (100 mi.)
